We also have 'Youth Sailing at Chase', a friendly way for young people, aged 10-18, to learn how to sail. As a

member racing is available in both class and handicap fleets, or you can relax and cruise around the pool. The Club House has secure changing rooms with showers. There is also a fully licenced bar within the Lichfield room with a pool table and television, a fully equipped kitchen for food preparation and wet area. Outside we have a secure compound with berths for boats and sailboards and parking is available both within the compound and on the foreshore.

As a guide for potential new members the Honorary Membership Secretary will apply the following criteria:-

| <i>Pensioner member</i> | Person who has attained State Pensionable age |
